

Prince Township has passed a resolution endorsing the WCO petition which is as follows:

"To The Legislative Assembly of Ontario:

WHEREAS there is a growing body of evidence confirming industrial wind development has serious adverse effects on host communities.

Whereas over one hundred and thirty-five people in Ontario have reported serious negative health effects from industrial wind development, and at least a dozen families have been bought out of their homes.

WHEREAS Ontario's Green Energy Act has ended local planning control, by stripping municipal councils of their rights.

WHEREAS Eighty municipal councils, representing two million Ontarians, called on the Government to put in place a full moratorium on industrial wind development until an independent epidemiological health study is completed, proper environmental regulations and protections are put in place, and local democracy is restored.

WE the undersigned petition the Legislative Assemble of Ontario as follows:

Immediately put a moratorium on all industrial wind proposals; fund an independent epidemiological health study to develop safe setbacks; legislate those findings; develop stringent environmental protection standards for natural areas; and require all projects to comply with regulations based on science and local planning."
